Secure Web Storage

Regensburg, January, 2018 – DRACCOON's end-to-end encrypting storage service can be used as a cloud service provided by a German data center or hosted on a local server. Stored files can be pointedly shared with other users without having to decrypt them on the server.

Client programs for Windows, macOS, Android, and iOS embed the cloud content as a virtual drive directly on the user's device. Alternatively, files can be uploaded and downloaded via a web browser and JavaScript. With an Outlook plug-in, DRACCOON enables sending email attachments with no size limit. To do so, the software attaches a link to the encrypted or unencrypted download in the outgoing email. Within a company account, several communication rooms with different access authorizations can be simultaneously maintained.

DRACCOON's commercial version initially costs 2880 Euros to be set up and beyond that starts at 600 Euros annually for the first 50 users. These users receive a storage quota of 100 GB each. Groups of up to 10 users can use the service for free, in which case a maximum of 10 GB of storage space is available.
